ORDINANCE # 2019-02

The Town Board of the Town of Draper, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 7.30(1), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 [or more] sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

There shall be 2 shifts for elections workers on all elections days. The first shift shall commence at 7 a.m. and end at 2 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 2 p.m. and end with the completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting as provided by s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
